## **Important Information for Graduation**

You need to be at school, in full formal uniform, no later than 3.00pm.

You need to line up in the general learning block.

Your **uniform will be checked** and if you are not dressed appropriately, you will **not be allowed to participate in the graduation**. Graduation is a privilege not a right!

You need to wear a **graduation gown**. These are hired from the school at a cost of **\$10.00** which needs to be paid to the front office by **19**<sup>th</sup> **September**.

You will need to collect your gown on Wednesday 26th September, at the conclusion of the rehearsal.

You will need to sign for your gown and sign it back in after the ceremony.

Graduation will be photographed including a year group photo on the steps too. You will need to advise the school in writing if you do not want your photograph to be published.

Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> September confirmation of your guest attending will need to be confirmed. Afternoon tea will be served after the ceremony.
