School Uniform Policy

Revised June 2018

It is the expectation of our school community that all students attending Erskine Park High School will be dressed in the school uniform. It should be the aim of every student to wear the uniform with pride and to take care of it. An added advantage is that the wearing of a uniform assists teachers to distinguish between intruders and students, thus making school uniform an issue of increased safety. Students who are not in full school uniform may not be able to represent the school on excursions or extra-curricular activities. Wearing the correct school uniform ensures all students meet the safety requirements for participating in practical lessons.

NOTE REQUIRED WHEN OUT OF UNIFORM

When a student is out of uniform for any reason, the school requires that a note, signed by a parent/guardian, be brought to school on the day and shown to one of the Deputy Principals in the morning by 8.20am. Students will then receive a **blue uniform pass** which any staff member may check throughout the day.

It is the student's responsibility to ask his/her parent for that note. We request this note as some students come to school in clothing in which they were not dressed when they left home. Parents will be phoned at times and letters sent home to ensure our school community's desire for uniform is upheld and our school image remains strong.

Shoes must be those specified – enclosed black leather shoes, black to the ground – so as to ensure student safety. Students without correct footwear will not be admitted to the school. Students CANNOT be admitted to laboratories, workshops or kitchens. It is unsafe to do so.

STUDENTS OUT OF UNIFORM WITHOUT A NOTE

Students who repeatedly attend school out of uniform and without a note from a parent/guardian will be managed in one of the following ways:

- Letters sent warning of our concerns regarding repeated uniform breaches
- Students may be asked to return home to change into correct clothing. Parents will be informed of concerns earlier by warning letter. Parent/caregiver contact will be made by phone securing permission before any student is asked to return home to change.

SUMMARY OF EXPECTATIONS

Expected uniform	Not permitted
School skirt, shorts, pants or trousers	Any other shirt, shorts, trousers or pants including shorts with logos, tracksuit pants, or items that are part of the school's PE/Sport uniform
School polo shirt, blouse or buttoned and collared shirt	Any other shirt or items that are part of the school's PE/Sport uniform
Navy blue school fleece top, school tracksuit jacket, school winter jacket, senior winter jumper	Any non-school uniform item including hooded tops, fleece tops and jackets.
	Any item of clothing that extends (ie: is visible) beyond school uniform polo shirt, blouse or buttoned and collared shirt.
Black, leather school uniform shoes	Any shoes that extend beyond the ankle, shoes that are not fully black, non-leather shoes
White socks, navy socks for boys wearing trousers.	Any socks that are not white, with the exception for boys wearing trousers – who are encouraged to wear navy socks.
